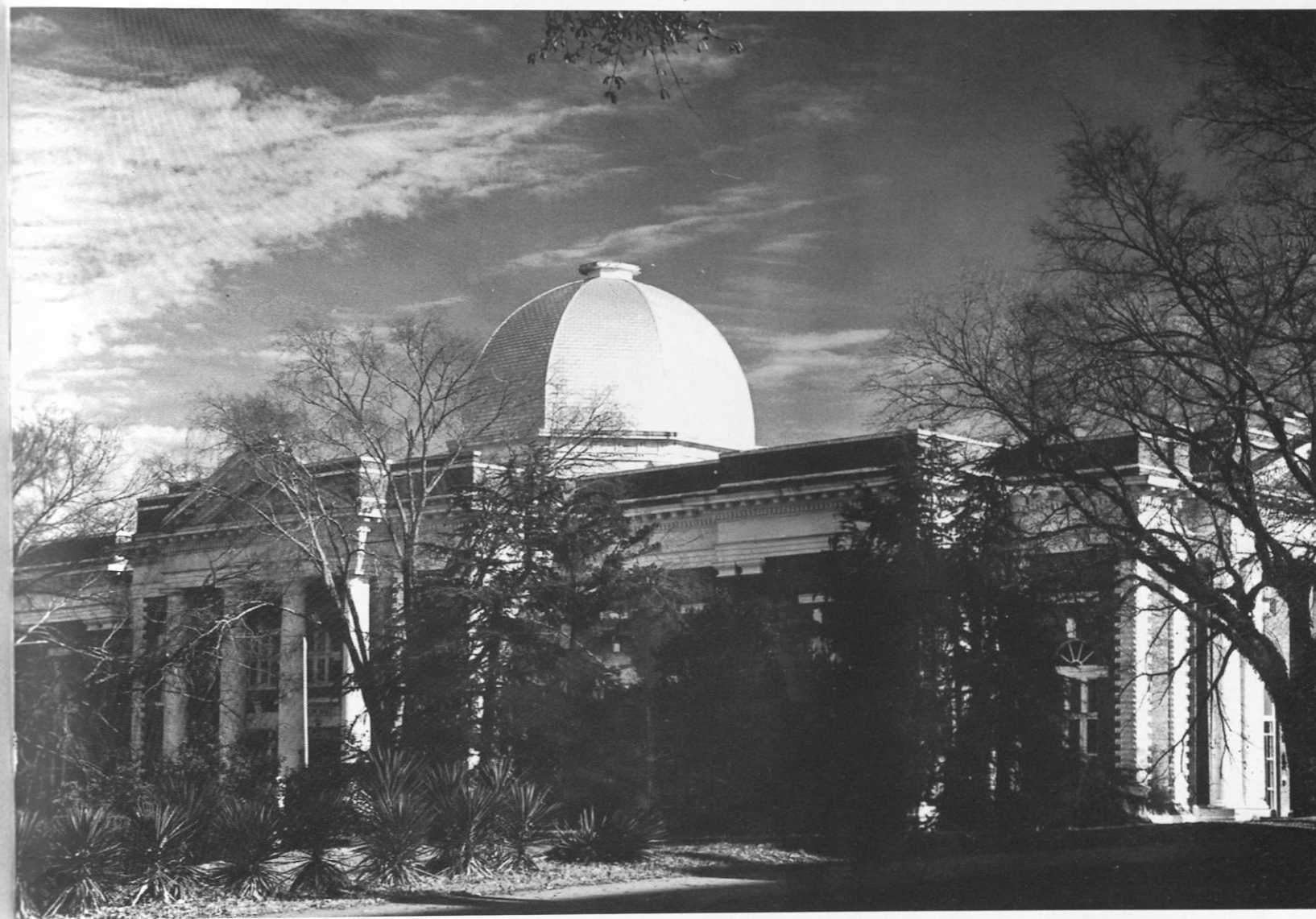




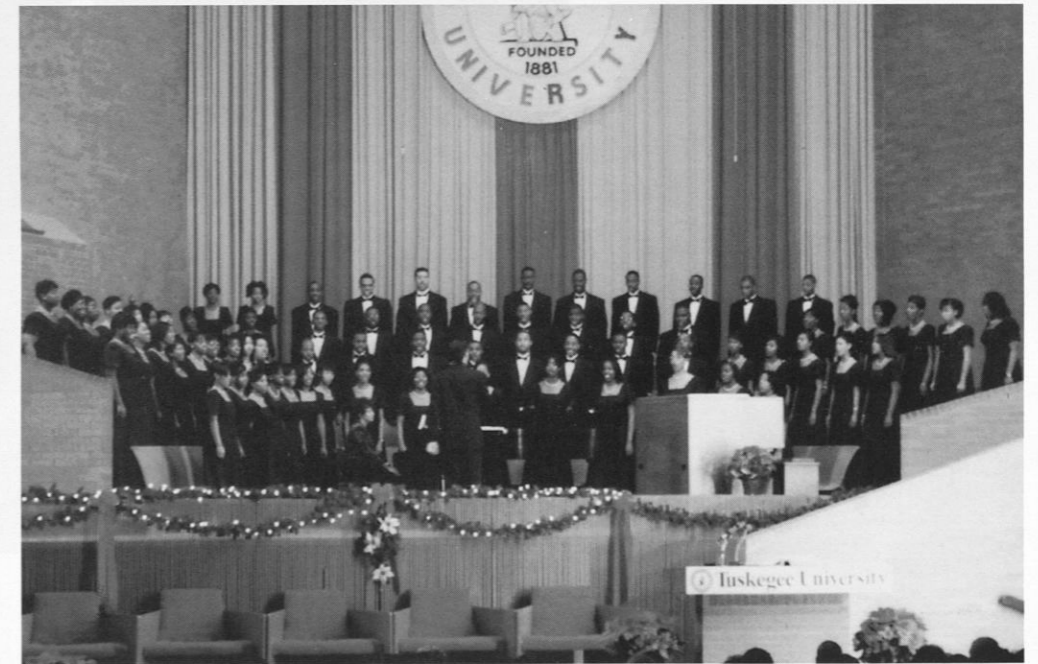

# MINDING OUR BUSINESS

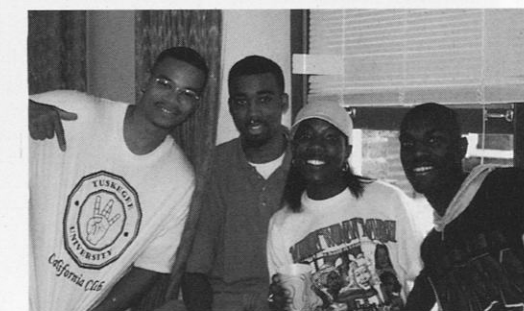
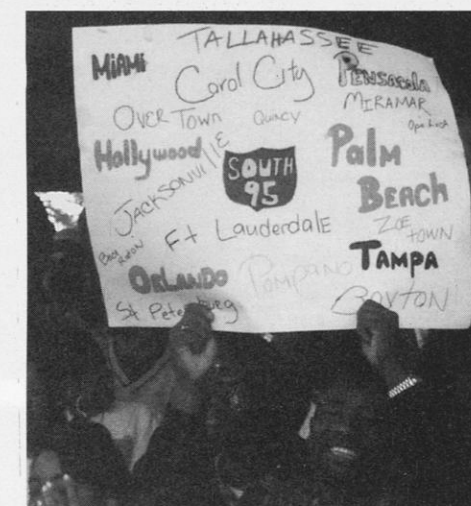
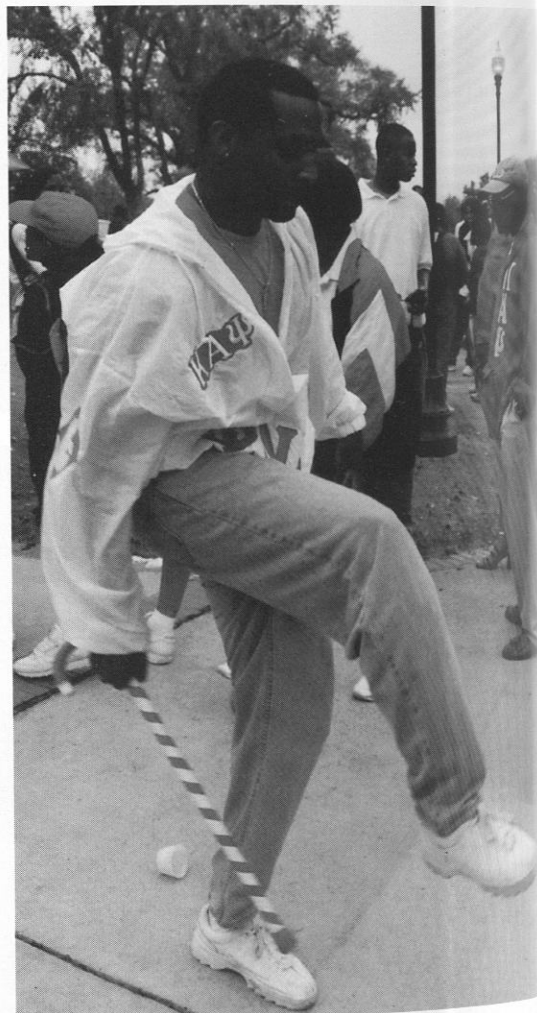
While we continue to struggle, our productivity and improvements always outweighed our problems.

## RAE LEWIS-THORNTON

### BIOGRAPHY

Young, educated, attractive, assertive and ambitious are just a few of the words used to describe Rae Lewis-Thornton. In 1986, during a routine blood drive visit at a Washington D.C. Red Cross, Rae received news of another word that would soon be used to describe her health and future. At the tender age of 23, Rae Lewis Thornton was diagnosed HIV Positive and given the ultimate death sentence.

Despite her present day status of having full-blown AIDS (Acquired Immune-deficiency Syndrome), Rae Lewis-Thornton leads her own unending crusade to educate and challenge young and old audiences to take control of their own bodies, futures and health. Rae uses her life as an example that AIDS is a non-discriminatory disease. She challenges the most common myths and stereotypes surrounding who and how one can become infected with the HIV virus that most often results in AIDS and death. In doing this, she incorporates her own oratory skills, personal experiences and unyielding honesty to create and disseminate her critical and deadly message of her own day by day, personal destruction by AIDS.

Featured on the cover of the December 1994 Essence magazine as well as in numerous feature stories in Ebony and Emerge magazines, Chicago Tribune newspaper, Chicago Sun-Times newspaper, Washington Post, Dayton Daily News and on several national television documentaries, news shows and television specials. Rae was featured on NIGHTLINE with Ted Koppel in a news article entitled "Rae's Story". The Oprah Winfrey Show had her on recently to share her story. Rae uses all forms of media to convey her message. Recently she served as a contributing editor for WBBM-TV, a CBS-owned and operated television station for an ongoing series of first person stories on living with AIDS. She received an Emmy Award for her series.

Prior to Rae's motivational speaking career, she was on her way to a promising political organizing career. Having served as Senator Carol Mosley Braun's 1992 Senatorial Campaign Advance Coordinator, Illinois State Youth Coordinator for the 1988 Dukakis Presidential Campaign and National Youth Director for Jesse Jackson's 1984 and 1988 Presidential Campaigns, Rae was forced to retire in 1993 as a result of her health.

Rae Lewis-Thornton is a magna cum laude university honors graduate of Northeastern Illinois University and a political science M.A. candidate at the University of Illinois. She is a member of the Women and Children AIDS Clinic Cook County Advisory Board, and the AIDS Pastoral Care Network Board of Directors. Rae Lewis-Thornton resides in Chicago with her loving and supportive husband, Kenny.

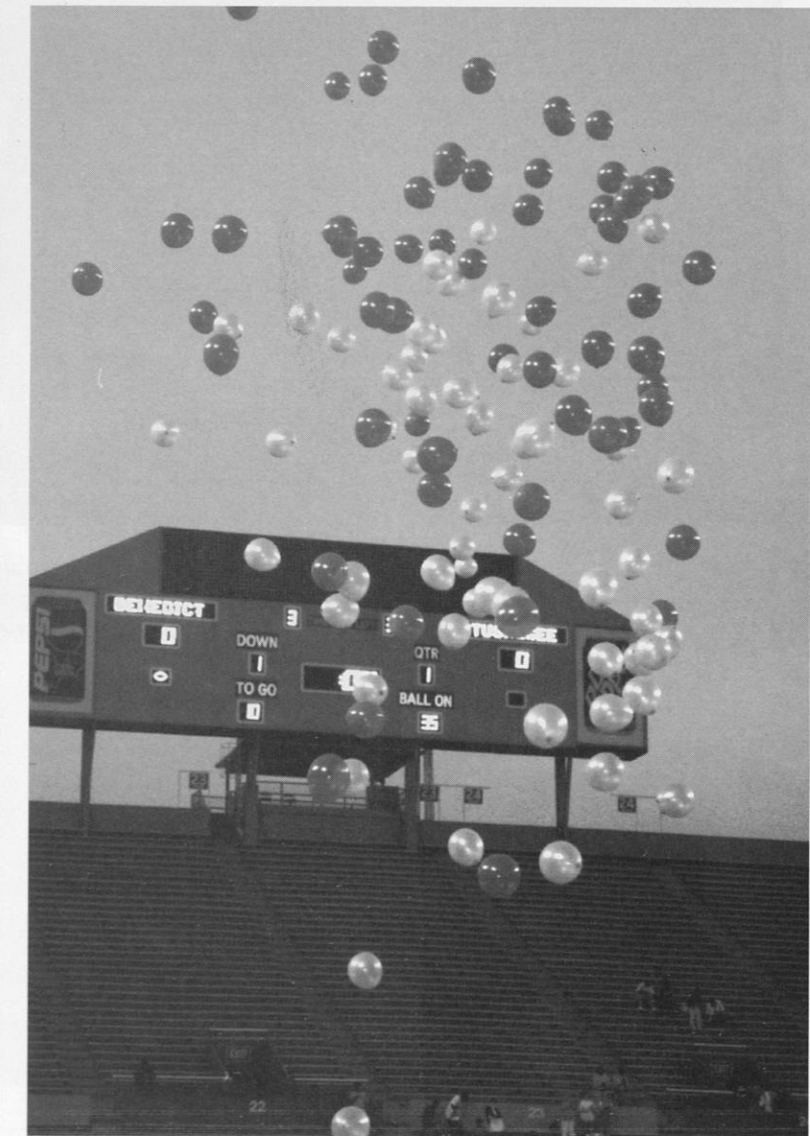

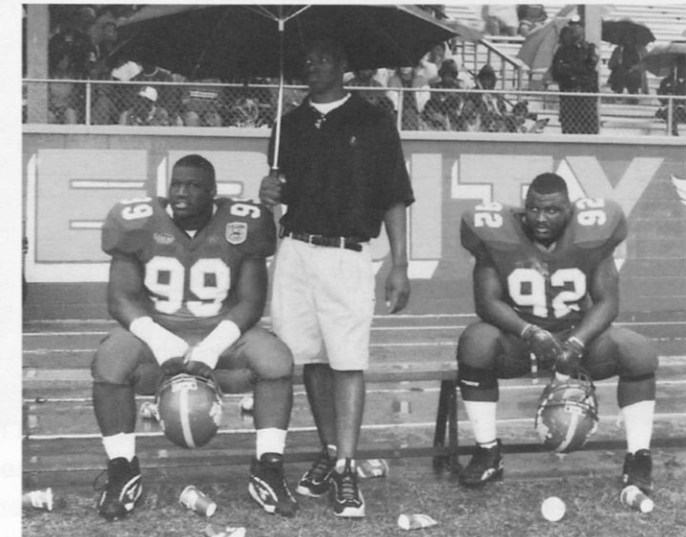

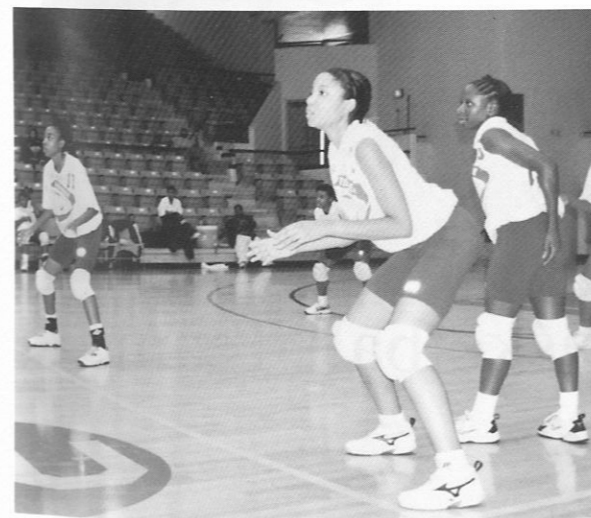
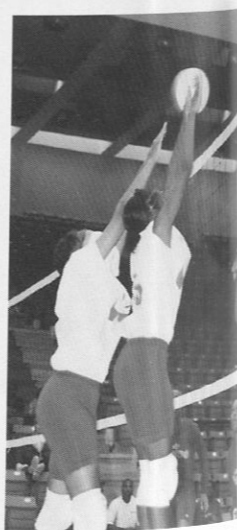
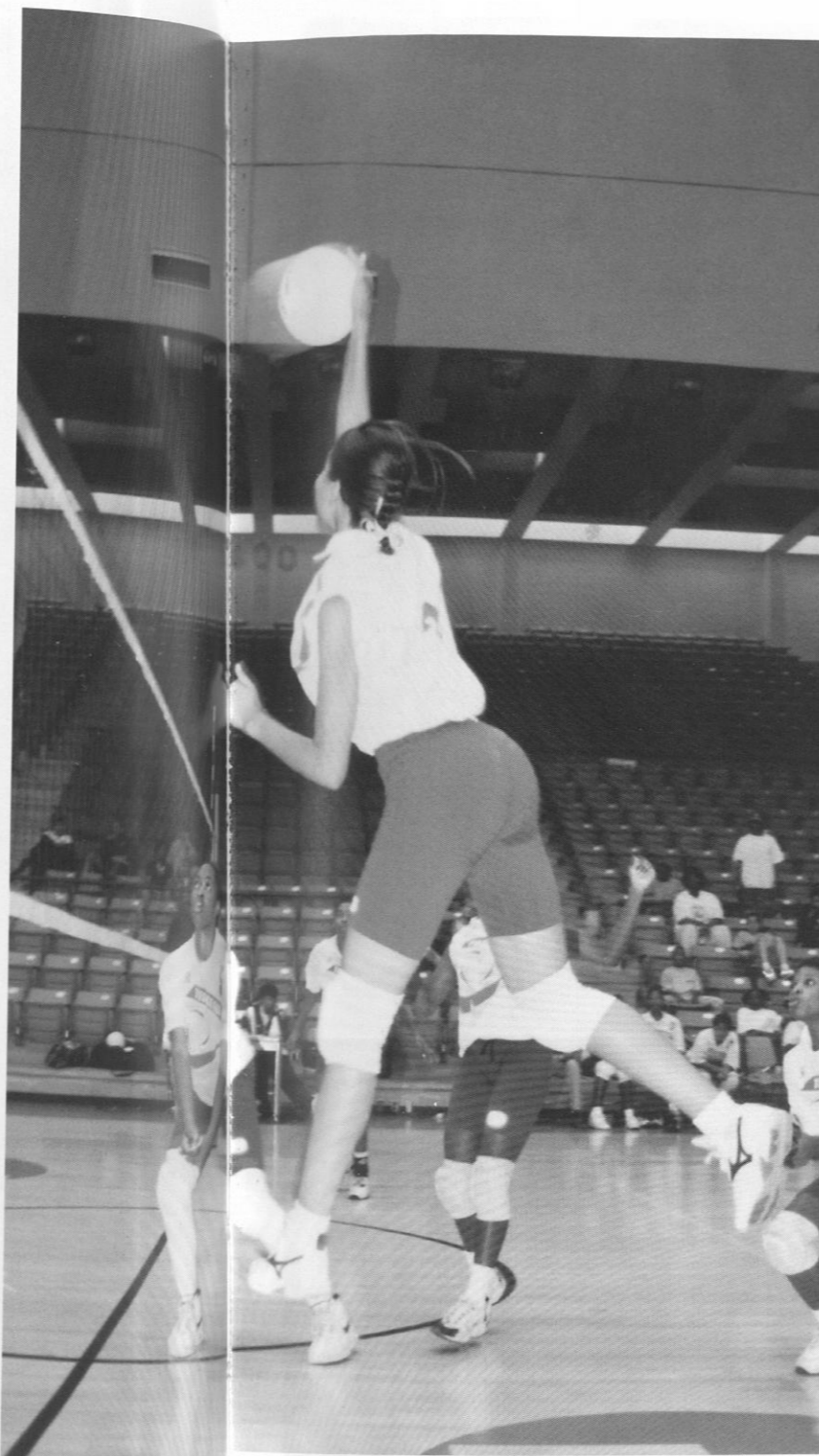


# Lady Golden Tigers Volleyball 1997

After winning only 6 matches in the last two years, the only thing on the Lady Golden Tigers minds was to win enough matches in order to qualify for the tournament.

With the large majority of his team returning, Head Volleyball Coach Pete Cardenas, was looking to boast up the team a little. After the 1996 season, Coach Cardenas recruited several freshmen and one junior college transfer.

Even though the Lady Golden Tigers open the 1997 volleyball season with a loss, they kept their heads up and turned it around with a victory against Judson College. After winning two more matches, the Lady Golden Tigers traveled to Atlanta to participate in the Clark Atlanta Volleyball Tournament. The Lady Tigers returned having played four matches, and winning two of the four. After winning three more matches, the Lady Golden Tigers returned home to participate in its own tournament. The Becky Jackson Classic included conference rivals Lemoyne-Owen and Savannah State in a one day tournament at Tuskegee in the Chappie James Center. The Lady Tigers finished the classic with a victory against both schools, while conference opponent Savannah State picked up its first win of the season with its victory over the Lady Magicians from Lemoyne-Owens. The Lady Golden Tigers would finish the season 12-8 overall, and advanced to the SIAC Volleyball Tournament, which was held this year in Albany, GA on the campus of Albany State University. The Lady Tigers played three matches, winning one out of three, and finishing fourth in conference. At the tournament banquet, senior outside hitter Tamika Stimpson and freshman hitter and setter Tileatha Williams were both named to the All-SIAC team. Freshman Tileatha Williams was the only freshman in the conference so named. The Lady Golden Tigers finished the season at 13-10 overall.

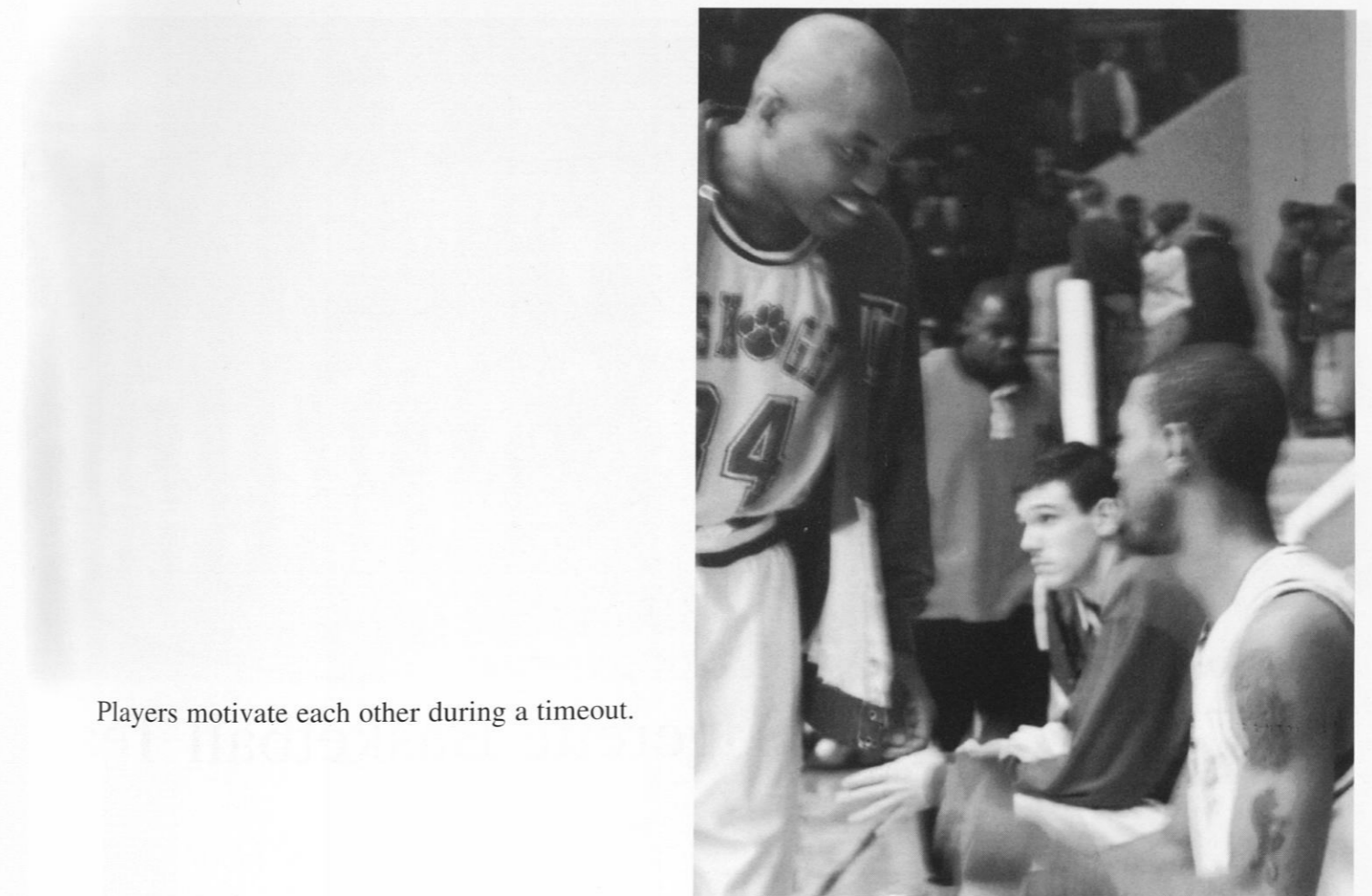

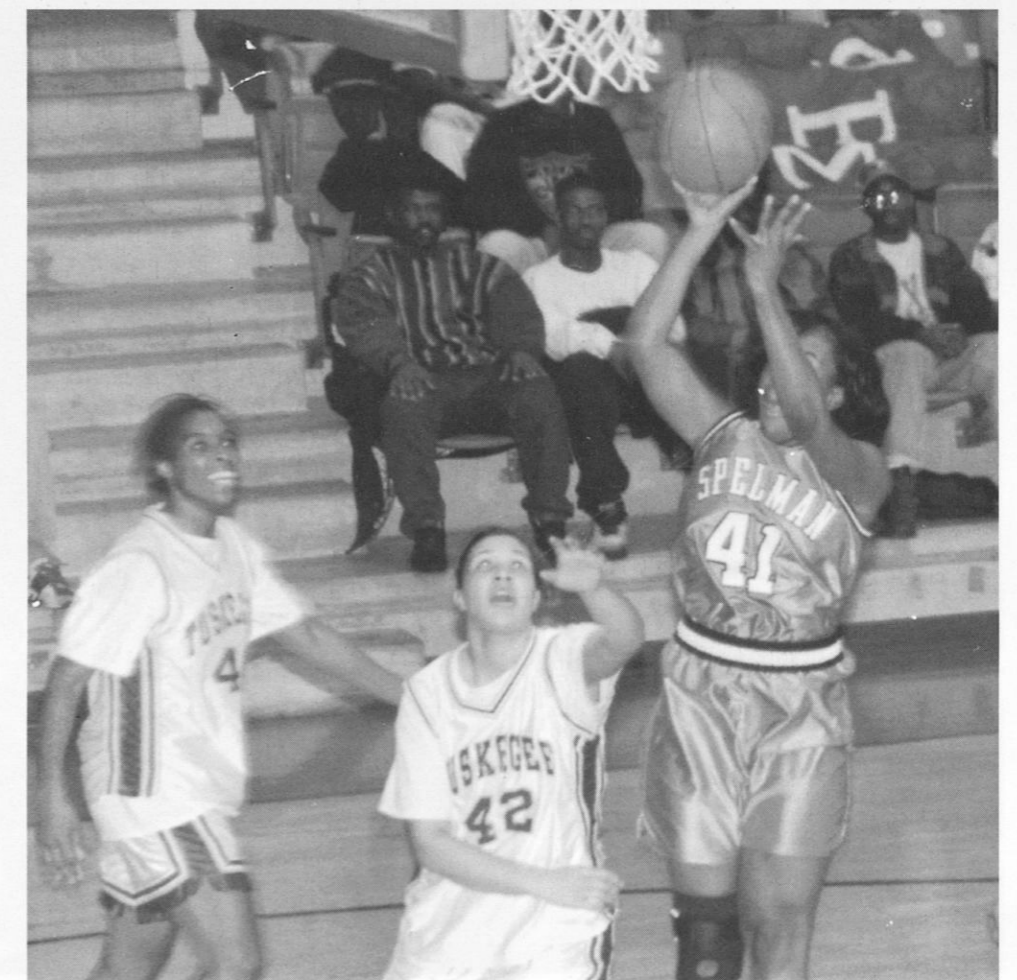

“They can do better if they attend classes more, utilize tutorials, and spend more time on out of class work to prepare for class. Students can treat themselves better. Do this and you will succeed.”

This is Dr. Lester’s advice for us for success at this prominent fast paced University. A native from Texas he has been a part of the T.U. family for thirty years. Some of our parents may remember him as a teacher in the mathematics department which is where he first started his long prosperous career at Tuskegee. He did an undergraduate at Prairie View A&M University in Mathematics, then he received his Ph.D. in Statistics at Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas.

If anyone has ever needed an administrative add or drop for a class, then they have seen Dr. Lester’s signature on the bottom, but his duties include much more. He is responsible for making sure department curriculum standards remain high for accreditation. He is the chief academic and student affairs officer of the University. He and The Dean of Students work together to plan co-curriculum programs to further the development of students through research programs and Student Affairs. As the Provost, he is also responsible for the policies and procedures in developing a curriculum.

Dr. Lester hope to bring Tuskegee into the technological era for he believes that computer literacy is one more key to the future. He is steadily working towards improvements such as better dorms, the commons apartment buildings, and attempts to raise school spirit.

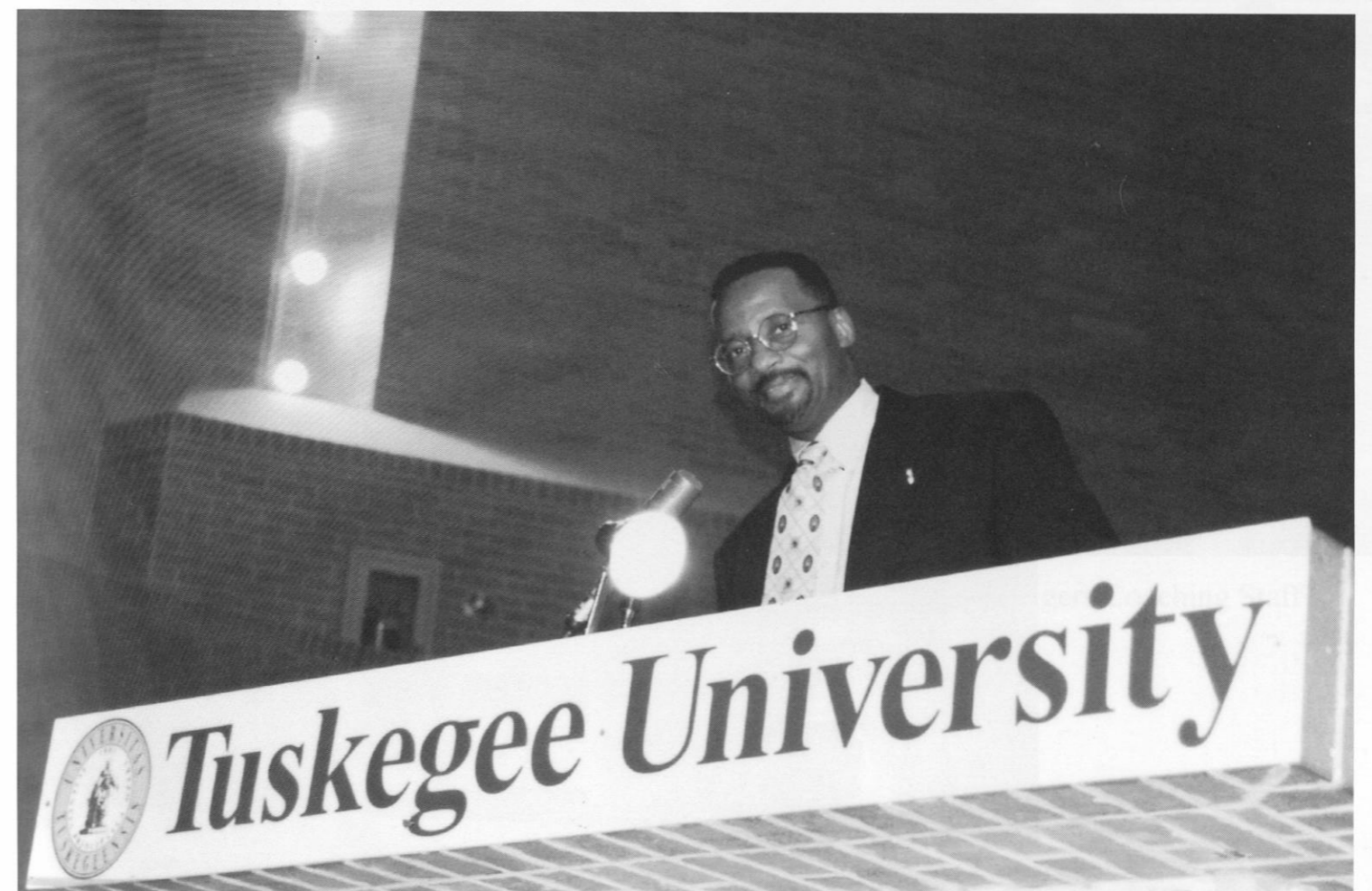

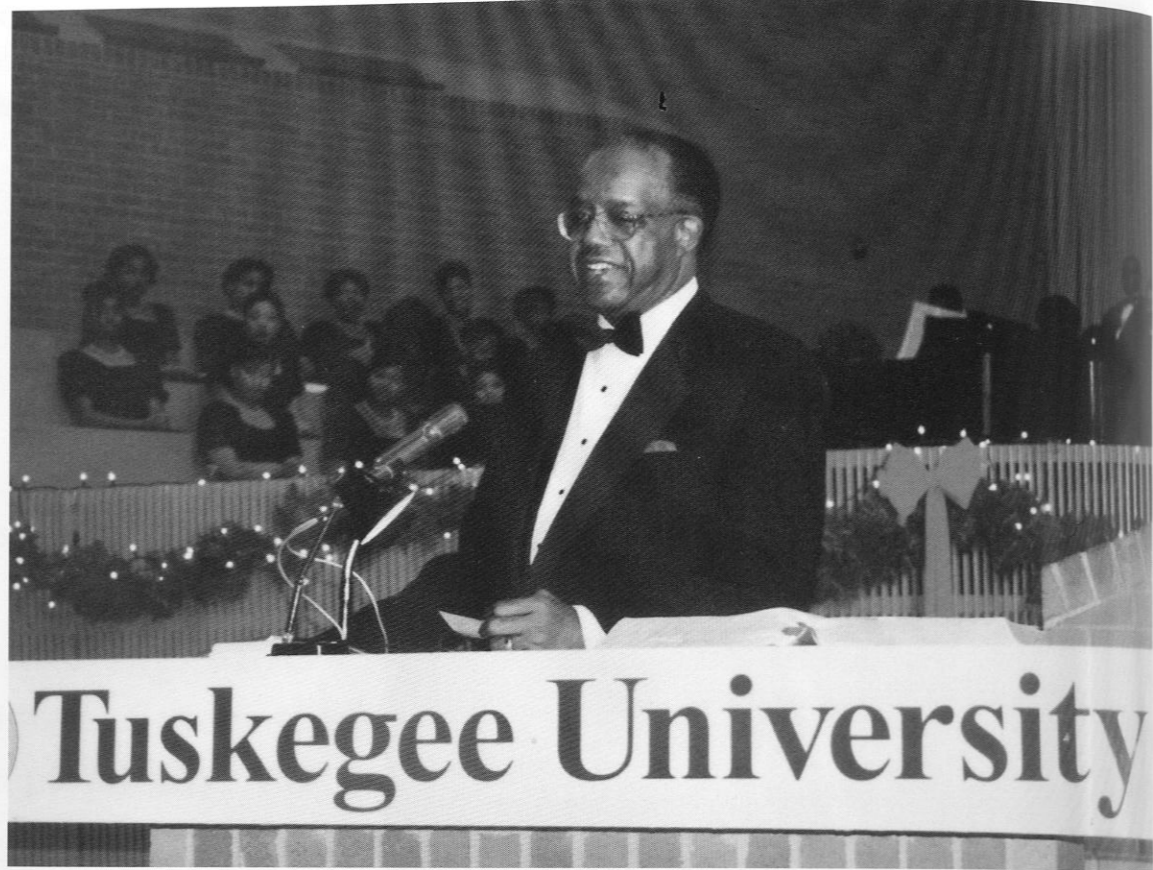

# Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Inc.

On January 16, 1920, Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorp. was founded on the campus of Howard University in Washington, D.C. by five coeds. These Five Pearls, Arizona Cleaver Stemmons, Pearl Anna Neal, Myrtle Tyler Faithful, Viola Tyler Goings, and Fannie Pettie Watts departed from traditional coalitions of Black women in order to establish an organization that would change the world. The first Greek letter organization to establish a chapter in Africa, Zeta is also the only sorority constitutionally-bound to a brother organization, Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Incorp.

In the spring of 1948 on April 15, Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorp. established Theta Beta chapter which was the first sorority on Tuskegee University's campus. For the past fifty years these sisters of the dove have freely given of their time and talents to make themselves known as a positive and integral part of the Tuskegee family and neighboring community.

A sisterhood with a lengthy history of service Zeta has actively participated in blood drives, tutorial programs, Operation Stork's Nest, adopt-a-dorm, annual Halloween parties for the children of Tuskegee, and the sleepout for the homeless in conjunction with the Beta Kappa chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Incorp. along with other numerous projects.

The chapter currently boasts fourteen active members. In keeping with the values of the Five Pearls they continue to blaze a path of service, scholarship, sisterly love and Finer Womanhood.
