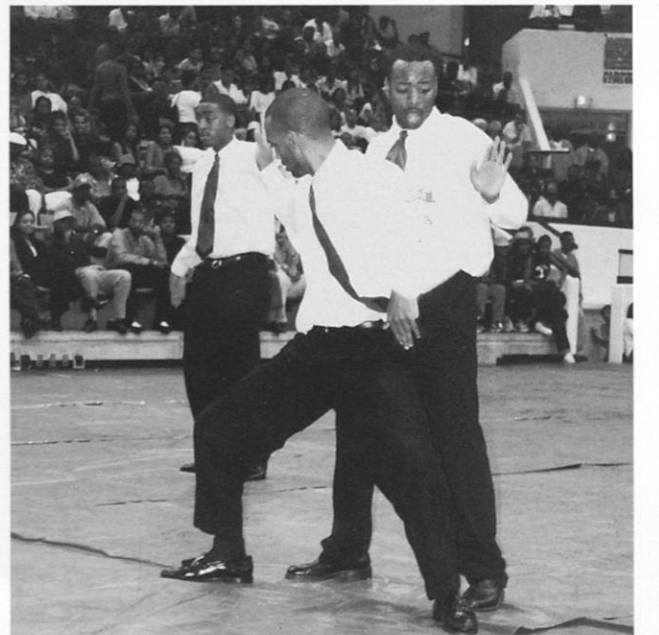
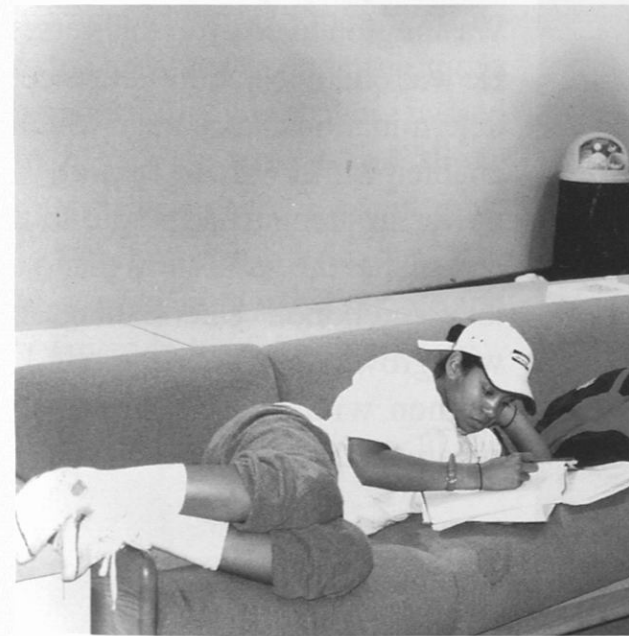
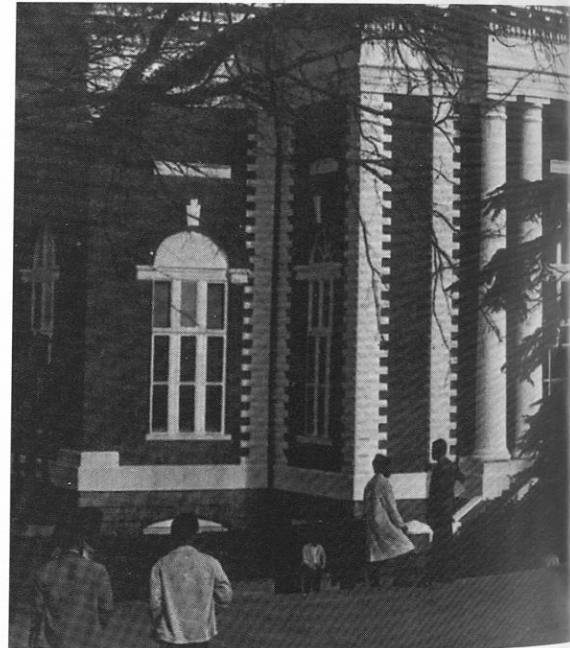
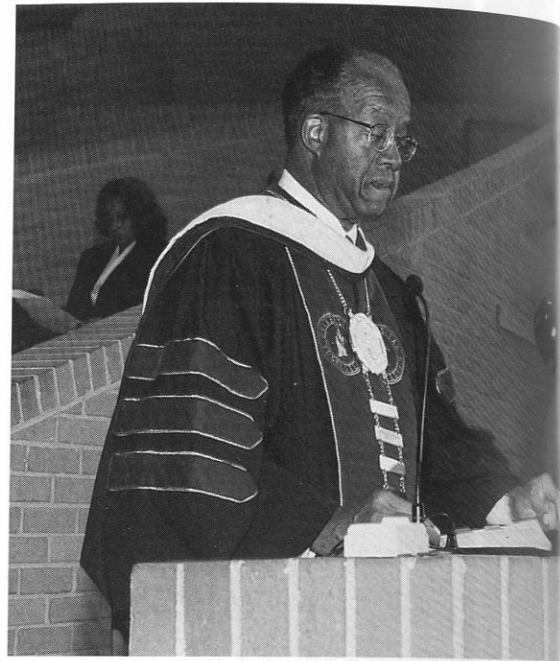


President Dr. Benjamin F. Payton
