# President Benjamin I. Payton







Kappa Alpha Psi was founded on the campus of Indiana University on January 5. The fraternity's fundamental purpose is achievement. Early is the century, American students were actively dissuaded from attending college. Formidable observer erected to prevent the few who were enrolled from assimilating into co-cum campus life. The ostracism characterized Indiana University in 1911, thus causing W. Diggs, Byron K. Armstrong, and eight other black students to form Kappa Alpastraternity, which remains the only Greek letter organization with its Alpha Chaptern University's campus.

This event to the office of biology Professor Ernest E. Just, the faculty adviser, in the Science Hall (now know at Thirkield Hall). The three liberal arts students were Edgar A. Love, Oscar J. Cooper and Flant Coleman.


From the initials of the Greek phrase meaning "friendship is essential to the soul," the name Ones. Psi Phi was derived. The phrase was selected as the motto. Manhood, scholarship, presentate and uplift were adopted as cardinal principles. A decision was made regarding the design for the pand emblem, and thus ended the first meeting of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity.









Zeta Phi Beta Sororiity, Incorporated was founded January 16, 1920 on the campus of Howard University in Washington, D.C. by five coeds. These women dared to depart from the traditional coalitions for Black women and sought to establish a new organization predicated on the precepts of Scholarship, Service, Sisterhood and Finer Womanhood.
