Kappa Alpha Psi was founded on the campus of Indiana University on January 5, 1908. The fraternity's fundamental purpose is achievement. Early in the century, African American students were actively dissuaded from attending college. Formidable obstacles were erected to prevent the few who were enrolled from assimilating into co-curious campus life. The ostracism characterized Indiana University in 1911, thus causing E. W. Diggs, Byron K. Armstrong, and eight other black students to form Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, which remains the only Greek letter organization with its Alpha Chapter on Indiana University's campus.
