FROM THE WISDOM OF ROBERT RUSSA MOTON (1867-1940)

President, TUSKEGEE INSTITUTE (1915-1935)
President-Emeritus (1935-1940)

I believe in my own people--in their native worth--in their attainments of character, accomplishment and service--and their ultimate high destiny in the progress of mankind.

I believe in my fellow-men of all races--in their right to an equal chance to share in all the good of this world--and my obligation to respect to the full their person and their personality.

I believe in the essential goodness of human impulses--in the instinctive desire to do what is just and right--and the will to respond to the noblest appeals.

I believe in the power of good over evil--the power of love over hate--the power of truth over error--and in the final and complete triumph of right over wrong.

I believe in freedom--in freedom to live one's life to the full--to serve wherever there is need--to achieve the limit of divine endowment.

I believe in patience--in the beneficent workings of time--that a Providence, wise and good, will, with the years, bring fruition to earnest hopes and honest strivings.

I believe in the fellowship of men of good will--in their ability to live together in peace--and to cooperate in service and in the pursuit of truth.

I believe in my friends--who know my strength and my weakness--their confidence is my inspiration--their loyalty my comfort--their approbation my greatest earthly satisfaction.

I believe in God--in His purposes of good toward all men--and the ultimate triumph of His justice and righteousness in all the earth.

* * * * *

May God grant that not a student here will neglect the teachings under which he was brought up. Crude sometimes were the prayers of your mothers and fathers, your grandmothers and grandfathers, and crude was the meeting place. The preachers themselves were perhaps unlettered and their sermons were often crude, but they were sincere and honest and earnest. It was that anchor of hope and faith that gave them courageous outlook into the future.

* * * * *

Make up your minds that your success depends upon yourself. Resolve that you are responsible for your success at Tuskegee and elsewhere, and that nobody else in the world is. In the same way your battles are being fought now, you must decide whether they will mean victories or defeats when you go out into life.

* * * * *

This school was not built for the faculty. These buildings, this equipment, and these grounds would not be here save that they are tools in the accomplishment of an important and absolutely necessary object. The faculty, buildings and equipment are necessary, but it is the student body that is the important thing. Dr. Washington came here forty odd years ago, for you. He did not come for himself. He gave up many things to come down here to this barren plateau in the midst of misunderstandings, suspicion and prejudice--prejudice not only of white people, but of colored people as well,--and in some ways the prejudice of his own race was more trying and more intense than that of the white. He came to Tuskegee for the boys and girls, for men and women, whom he might, perchance, under God, be able to help and influence for good. (September 14, 1924)

My thought was to get sufficient education to do things better and to save myself the embarrassment which I frequently underwent because I did not know as much as many people in the community thought I did.

* * * * *

There was never any question, even from my earliest youth, I think, as to my desire to be helpful to my people; but exactly how it should be done was not wholly clear.

* * * * *

If we are to be true to this great and sacred trust; if we are to carry out the aims and purposes of Booker T. Washington, we must cherish and maintain the spirit which has always permeated the life and work of this place-- the spirit of self-forgetfulness--the spirit of service and sacrifice-- the Tuskegee Spirit--the Spirit of Cooperation and of Consecration. It is only in this Spirit that Tuskegee Institute can continue to render service to our People, to our State and to our Country.

ROBERT RUSSA MOTON

Booker T. Washington is remembered as the Founder of Tuskegee Institute. Many may well refer to Robert Russa Moton as the Builder. A Builder of the Physical Plant, of the Curricula, and of Human Relations. Dr. Moton realized that if Tuskegee-trained men and women were to continue to hold their place in the sun, Tuskegee must be geared to the tempo of the times.

Dr. Moton took the "Tuskegee Spirit" which he inherited, and made of it a symbol-- two-fold in conception: the one a tribute to the Founder and the other an incentive for service. His directness, his simplicity, his honesty and earnestness were quite disarming and strongly persuasive. He is immediately revealed as a man who loves mankind. His method was that of unreserved frankness and unlimited charity. Nothing was gained by a policy of concealment. No adjustment of problems were made with a lack of understanding or a spirit of sympathy.
